UC Irvine,	UC San Diego,	UC Santa Cruz.
- ▽ a support network for the leaders of the lesbian, gay and bisexual organizations at each of the UC campuses.
- ▽ the means for them to exchange information system-wide.
- ▽ the means for them to work together in regards to:
  - establishing **Chancellor's Committees** on LGBs; establishing **LGB Resource Centers**; promoting **LGB curriculum**; establishing **LGB Studies Programs**; discrediting **ROTC** within the UC system; establishing **Domestic Partnership Rights** in Married/Family Student Housing and with employee spouse benefits; and other LGB affirmative projects.
- ▽ the means to promote and provoke communication between lesbians, gays and bisexuals in the UC system.
- ▽ the means to address on a system-wide level issues including, but not limited to, ableism, ageism, anti-semitism, apathy, bigotry, biphobia, classism/elitism, heterosexism, internalized homophobia, invisibility, misogyny, racism, separatism, and sexism.
- ▽ the means to empower the UC lesbian, gay and bisexual communities' visibility, and thus to further Lesbian, Gay and Bisexual Pride.
- ▽ open to UC undergraduates, graduates, faculty, staff, administrators and alumni of all sexual, political, religious, economic, ethnic and gender identities.
